The Ohio Federation of Fire Chaplains welcomes you to their third annual Spring training event. We have expanded to a three-day format and are please to offer two tracks of training.

Track 1, day 1 will offer Line of Duty Death Training (LODD) and an orientation of the "Everyone Goes Home" program of the National Fallen Firefighters Foundation. These courses will be offered by Instructors of the Ohio Fire Chief's Association. Days 2 and 3 will offer the Essentials of Fire Chaplaincy course, the basic training for Fire Chaplains.

You may choose a "Wednesday Only Option" in Track 1 for a cost of \$50. See registration form.

On Track 2, we will offer Pastoral Crisis Intervention I and II, approved by the International Critical Incident Stress Foundation (ICISF) in a three day, 26 contact hour, format. Instructor for this course will be Chaplain Glenn Calkins, D. Min., and ICISF approved Instructor. Fulfillment of PCI I and II qualifies as a class in ICISF's Certificate of Specialized Training Program. See their web site, www.icisf.org, for further information of their programs.

Cost for each Track is \$150 with the Essentials Manual an additional \$50. Accommodations are available at the Ohio Fire Academy.

Registration begins at 7:30 a.m. on Wednesday, April 27 with instruction beginning at 8:30 a.m. Training on Thursday and Friday will begin promptly at 8:00 a.m. Certificates for both Tracks will be given at the conclusion of the training and Certificates cannot be given for partial attendance.
